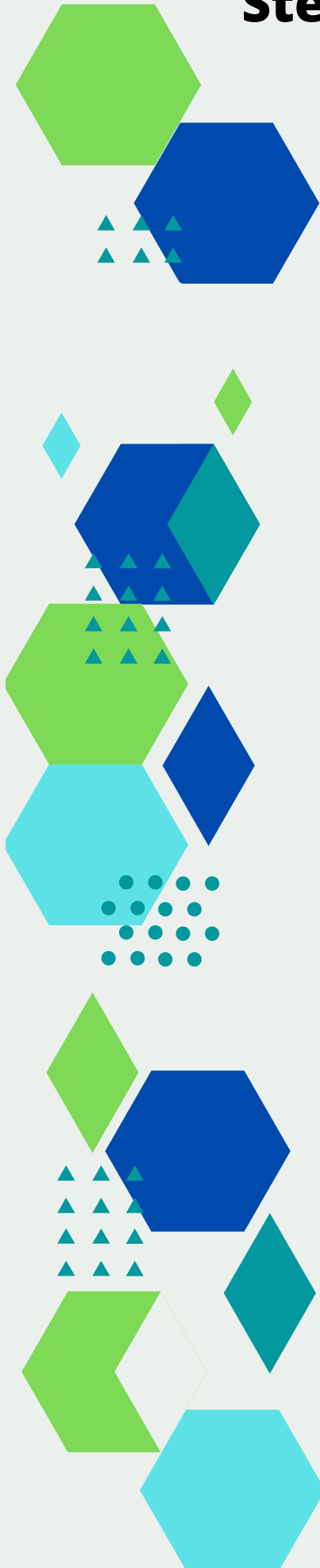
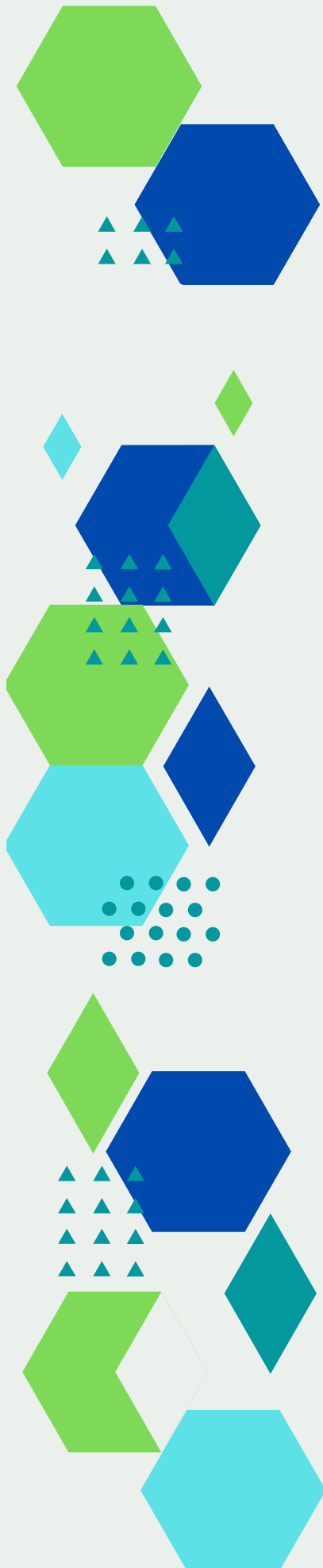


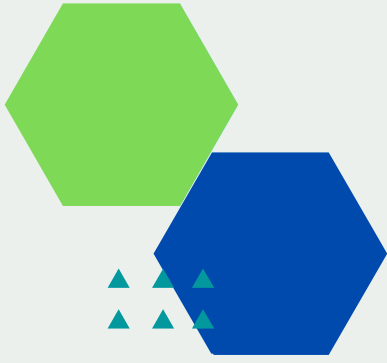
# Stephanie Larry Daniel
